Summary

Repairs damaged bodies and body parts of automotive vehicles such as automobiles, buses, and light trucks. Repairs damaged fiberglass. Sprays surfaces of machines, manufactured products, or working area with protective or decorative material such as paint, enamel, glaze, gelcoat, or lacquer. Must have ability to complete work start to finish, to include repair, prep, paint, clean, and reassemble.

Reasonable Accommodations Statement

Essential Functions

- Examines damaged vehicles and estimates cost of repairs.
- Removes upholstery, accessories, electrical window and seat operating equipment, and trim to gain access to vehicle body and fenders.
- Straightens sheet metal.
- Fills depressions with body filler.
- Removes damaged fenders and panels. Bolts or welds replacement parts in position.
- Files, grinds, and sands repaired surfaces to match original contour.
- Refinishes repaired surface.
- Smooths and paints surfaces after performing body repairs.
- Assist mechanic with repairs and/or replacement of defective mechanical parts.
- Cuts away damaged fiberglass.
- Masks surrounding undamaged surface.
- Soaks matting in resin mixture and layers matting over repair area to specified thickness.
- Occasionally secures new panel to repair area.
- Polyresin repair.
- Cleans repair area with air gun.
- Cleans grease and dirt from product to prep for repair and painting.
- Selects and mixes coating liquid to produce desired color.
- Turns sprayer valves and nozzle to regulate width and pressure of spray.



- Pulls trigger and directs spray onto work surface to apply prime or finish coat.
- Cleans spraying equipment and brushes with solvent.
- Removes and repairs rust.
- In addition to the above job description when the body shop employee does not have work to perform on the above items will assist bus cleaners, mechanic helpers and building maintenance. See appropriate job description.
- Other duties as assigned

- High School Diploma/GED Required.
- 3+ years' experience in fleet body repair/fiberglass work/painting
- General welding knowledge and experience
- Personal set of tools, to include painting equipment and hand tools.

Ability to:

- Obtain, possess, and maintain a Class B Commercial Driver's License with passenger and air brake endorsements, *preferred*.
- Read, write, and speak English fluently.
- Successfully complete a background check up to Burlington Trailways standards.
- Stay current with DOT/FMCSA/FTA regulations pertaining to position.
- Perform work accurately and thoroughly and take accountability for such work.
- Demonstrate strong work ethic, honesty, integrity, reliability, and self-motivation.
